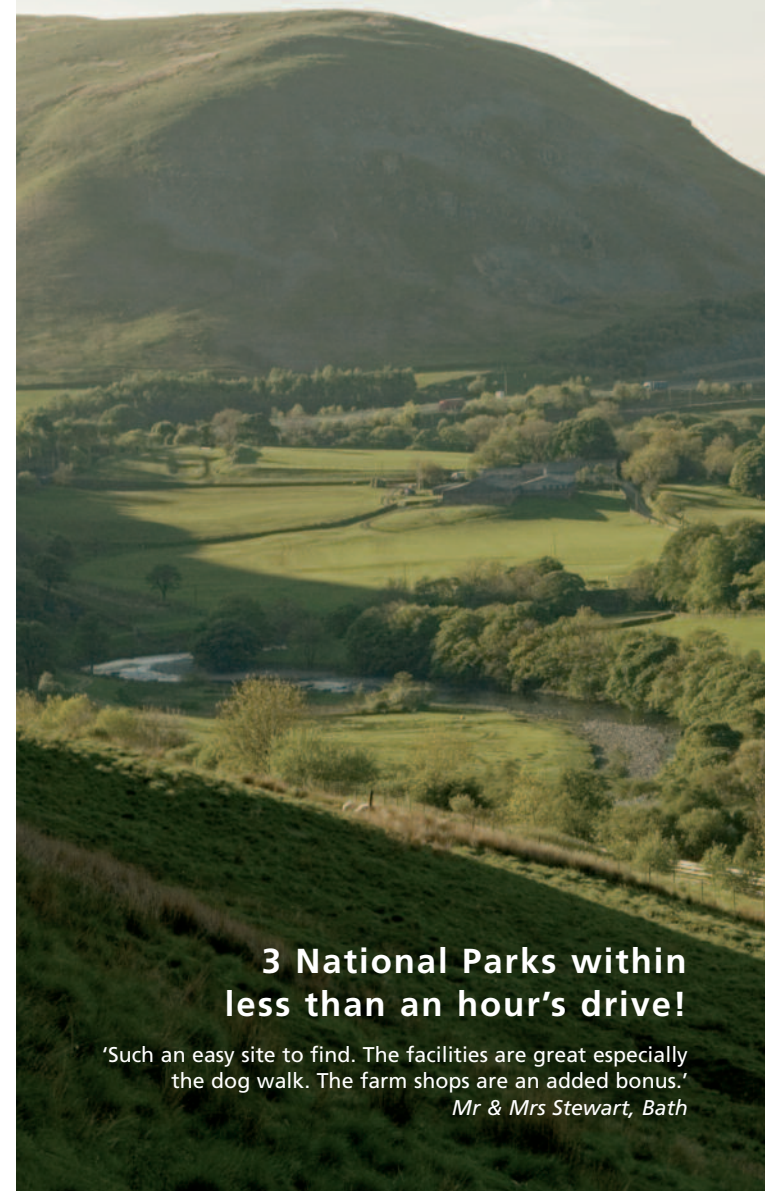
Westmorland Farm Shop - open daily

How to find us

Westmorland Caravan Park is situated 1 mile north of J38 on the M6 near Orton and is reached via the award winning Tebay Services northbound. Southbound travellers will be directed over the motorway bridge to the northbound services. The site is clearly signposted from both service areas.

As you drive into the park the reception is on your right. Please park and check in and we will allocate your pitch. Arrivals any time after 2pm. (Late arrival area for travellers arriving after 10pm).

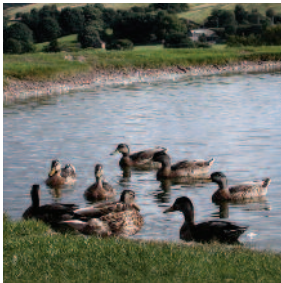
